What is it?

The Pet Transitional Living Program was created to provide shelter for family pets who could be in danger.

Pets are an important part of households. If domestic violence is prevalent, the family pet may also become a victim.

An abuser may threaten, batter or kill the family pet in an effort to maintain power and control over their victims.

Many victims of domestic violence will not seek shelter if there is no safe place for their animals to go.

- 71 percent of domestic violence victims reported that their abuser also targeted pets.*
- Researchers found that pet abuse had occurred in 88 percent of the families under supervision for physical abuse of their children.*
